About Calicut University Four-Year Undergraduate Programme (CUFYUGP)

As per the provisions of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, the University of Calicut introduced Four-Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) in 2024-25 academic year. Students seeking admission for the degree programme must register for four-year UG programmes hereafter.

Broad Pathways of Study

There are three broad pathways of study in FYUGP: A student can choose any one of the pathways as per his/her wish and depends on his/her performance.

(a) 3-year UG Degree: required to complete minimum of courses totaling 133 credits, like prevailing Degree.

(b) 4-year UG Degree (Honours): required to complete specific number of courses totaling 177 credits over four years of study.

(c) 4-year UG Degree (Honours with Research): required to complete 177 credits, including 12 credits of research project/dissertation in their Major discipline.

Academic Pathways

- 1. Single Major:** Any Single Major Subject like Physics, Chemistry, Commerce, Management, English, Economics, Computer Science, etc., Plus a set of SIX courses from different discipline subjects.
- 2. Major with Multiple Disciplines:** A Major subject Plus Two related Major Subjects
- 3. Major with Minor:** A Major subject Plus courses from a Minor subject
- 4. Major with Vocational Minor:** A Major subject Plus courses from a Vocational Minor Subject
- 5. Double Major:** All courses from Two Major Subjects

The Grace Valley College offers two broad pathways – 3-year UG Degree and 4-year UG Degree (Honours) with a choice of five academic pathways.



ADMISSION

MERIT QUOTA

Admission to merit seats is being conducted through Centralised Admission Process (CAP) by the Director of Admission, University of Calicut and the student seeking admission will apply online within the time prescribed by the University. 50% of seats will be filled in the merit quota.

MANAGEMENT QUOTA

The students seeking admission in the management quota will register their name in the CAP of the University. 50% will be filled in the management quota. The students will apply in the separate application form available in the college office for consideration in the management quota. Parents or guardian should accompany their wards during interview and the original certificates should submit at the time of admission. The candidates are advised to keep enough number of attested copies of certificates for further use. A set of Xerox copy of all certificates should be submitted at the office while admission.

ONLINE SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION FORM

- Enter a valid email ID for verification purpose. Verify your email ID using the OTP sent to your registered email address.
- Enter the applicant's name, phone number and date of birth.
- Fill in the Personal Information section and submit.
- Select the programmes and quota (Merit/Management) and submit.
- Upload the applicant's photo and signature in JPEG format (size specified in the application).
- Enter the marks secured in the relevant section. Editing or deleting the entered marks is possible.
- Upload the required mark list and other scanned documents & make the payment online.
- Fill in the applicant's bank details or skip if not required.
- Finally, review the application and ensure all necessary information is filled correctly.
- FINALIZE the application. Corrections or modifications cannot be made after this step.
- After final submission, you can print out a copy of the application for your records.
